Reserve Bank of India

Meeting held with Audit Relation Group, RBI

A meeting was held with the Audit relation group of the RBI to discuss various issues concerning the audit profession in the banking industry, concerns raised by members with respect to a situation where the partnership firm loses the opportunity to get empaneled with RBI owing to the fact that it has only one partner being exclusively associated with the firm were taken up by ICAI.

Suggestions submitted to RBI on issues concerning the audit profession in the Banking Industry

Suggestions were made to RBI for introduction of additional criteria for categorization of firms, Reintroduction of cooling period in Public Sector Banks, increase in audit fee for Statutory Central and Branch Audit Assignments, Increase in Coverage of Advances vis-à-vis Concurrent Audit System, Proposal for Separate Norms for Appointment / Re-appointment of Statutory Branch Auditors of State Co-operative Banks and Central Co-operative Banks etc.

Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI)

Meeting was held with the Insurance Advisory Committee of the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India, during the meeting various suggestions were made on various items concerning the IRDAI (BIMA Sugam) Regulations, 2024; IRDAI (Registration, Capital Structure, Transfer of Shares, and Amalgamation of Insurers) Regulations, 2024; IRDAI (Corporate Governance for Insurers) Regulations, 2024; and IRDAI (Actuarial Finance and Investment Functions of Insurers) Regulations, 2024, IRDAI (Maintenance of Information by regulated entities and sharing of information by the Authority), Regulations, 2024 etc.

NITI Aayog

A meeting was held regarding the collaboration between ICAI and NITI Ayog WEP for empowering women entrepreneurs and the support NITI Ayog in its related endeavours. It was submitted that the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) can effectively and actively contribute to policy making processes within NITI Aayog, fostering collaboration and leveraging its vision to drive sustainable economic growth and financial governance.

Ministry of Cooperation

- A meeting was held with Joint Secretary and Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Ministry of Cooperation wherein various issues relating to the panel of auditors for Multi State Cooperative Societies prepared by the office of Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies.
- A meeting was held with Joint Central Registrar of Cooperative Societies, Ministry of Cooperation to discuss issues related to the empanelment of auditors for UCBs and Multi State Cooperative Banks.

Meeting with the Office of Comptroller & Auditor General of India

- A meeting was held with the office of C&AG regarding the issues reported by members due to suspension of internet services owing to the ongoing farmer protest in various regions of Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh and outskirts of Delhi & NCR. Further a representation was submitted to O/o C&AG to consider opening the online application for empanelment for Chartered Accountants Firms/LLPs for the year 2024-25 for two days.
- Representations were submitted with regard to data furnished with O/o C&AG under the head "Branch details". In order to address these representations, a One-Time online window was opened from 05.07.2024 to 08.07.2024, to update/add/delete the data relating to their branch offices along with their members stationed at a particular branch office submitted by the applicants in their Online application filed with O/o C&AG.
- A meeting was held with Director General (Commercial-II), O/o C&AG of India to share the preliminary inputs on the feedback on the policy of empanelment and allotment of Chartered Accountants.

The Red Flag system streamlines financial document audits by enhancing efficiency and accuracy. Approved at the Council's 356th meeting, it enables 100% document review, automates red flag detection, and ensures compliance through independent audits.

Category Calculator

The MEF process has been streamlined with the successful implementation of the "Category Calculator," enabling applicants to determine their category based on RBI's revised norms.

Introduction of additional category apart from Categories of RBI

To support newer and smaller firms lacking an RBI qualification track record, the PDC introduced MEF Category "OA" (Other Assignments) for non-statutory audits like concurrent and stock audits. This includes proprietors, partnerships, or individual practitioners exclusively associated with the applicant as of July 1, 2024. Banks and relevant authorities will be informed.

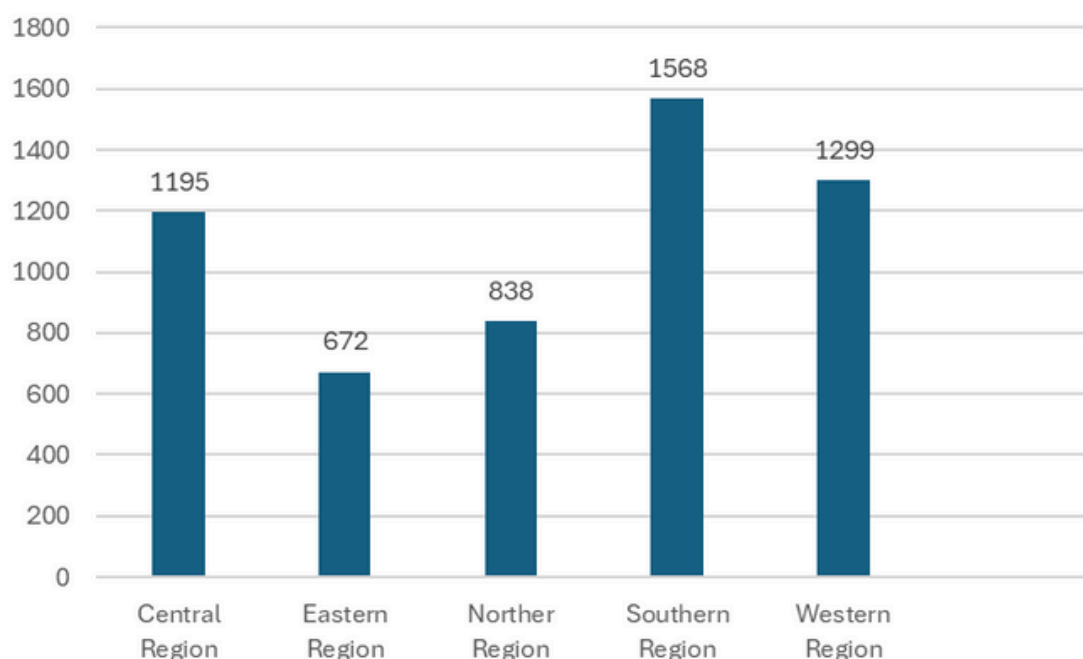

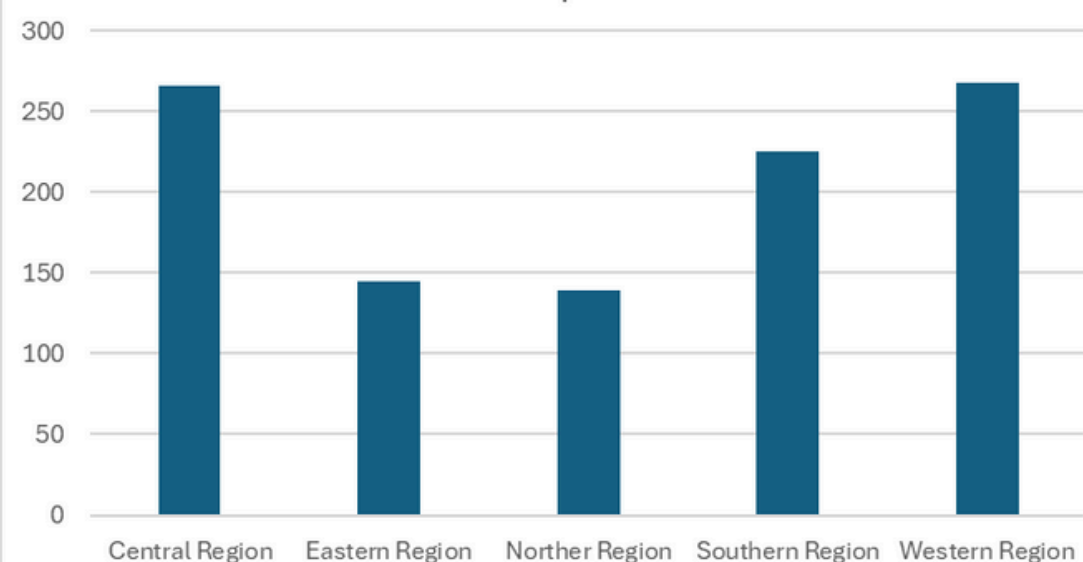
DIRM

No. of members registered to the DIRM Course

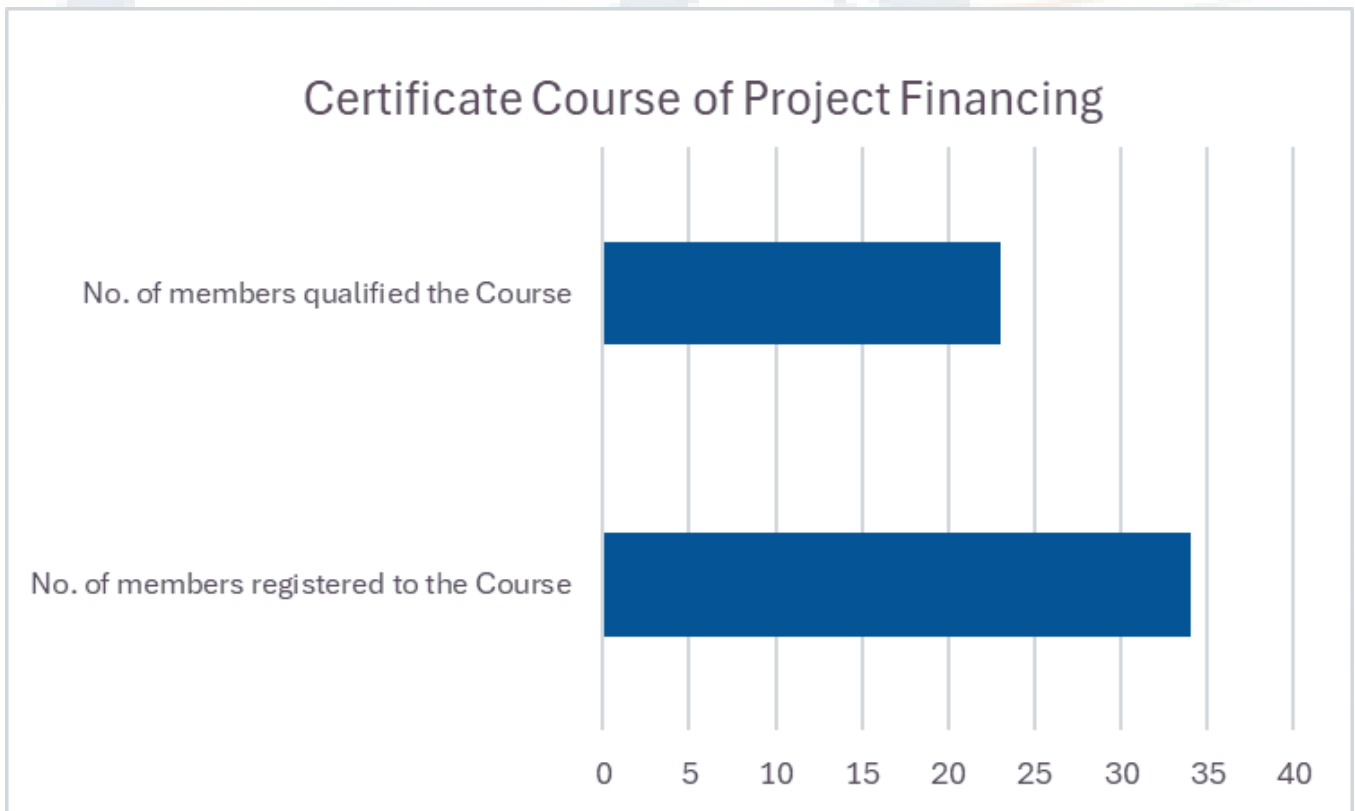


No. of members qualified DIRM Course

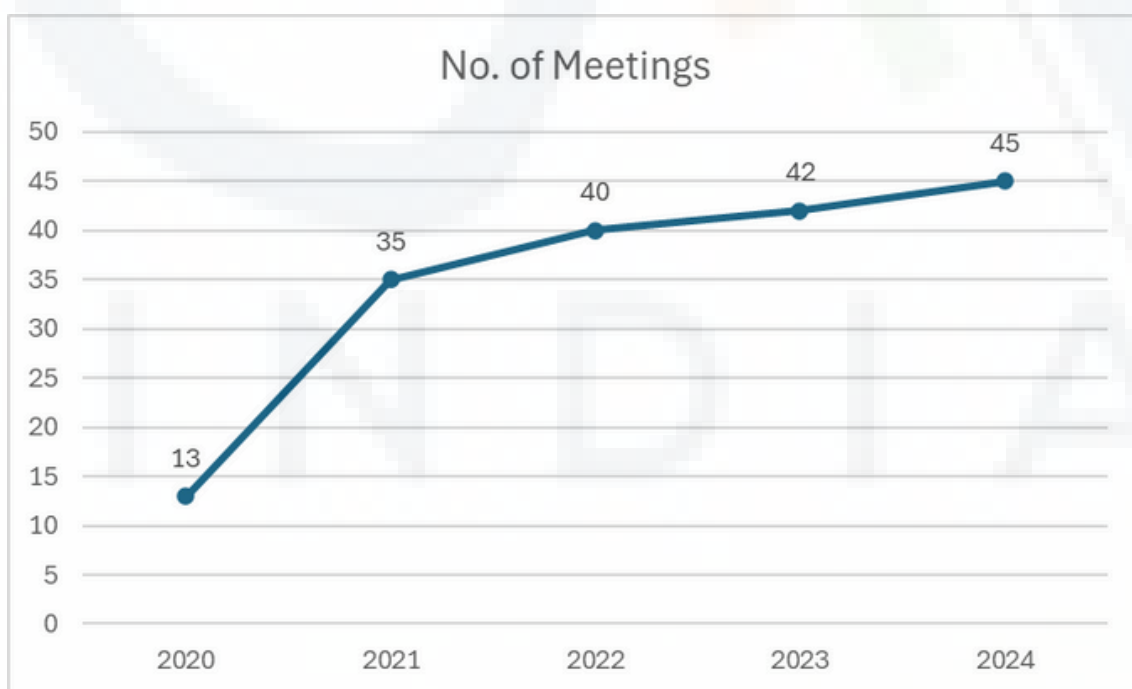
State Level Coordination Committee (SLCC)/ Sub-SLCC Meetings

The Reserve Bank of India holds quarterly meetings of State Level Coordination Committee to regulate Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs) and deposit accepted activities of incorporated bodies (UIBs) at each of their regional offices.

Such meetings are convened by Regional Director of respective regional office of RBI and attended by Principal Secretary/Secretaries of various departments such as Finance, Home, Law

of respective states, National Housing Board (NHB), Securities Exchange Board of India (SEBI), Registrar of Companies (RoC), Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDA), Registrar of Chit Fund and the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI).

More than 45 SLCC/ Sub-SLCC meetings were held during the year and were attended by the representatives of ICAI.



Initiatives for Members



→ Introduction of additional category apart from Categories of RBI

Another effort has been made by PDC of ICAI to provide opportunities to newer or smaller firms that have potential and enthusiasm but lack the necessary track record. Such firms who do not fit in RBI qualification norms for statutory auditors are categorized as "Not Eligible" as of now. This creates great impediment for these firms in getting even other assignments from Banks and financial institutions. To facilitate such firms, the PD Committee introduced an additional category in MEF for assignments other than statutory branch audits such as concurrent audits, stock audits, etc.

This new category is referred to as Category "OA" (Other Assignments). This category comprises of proprietor firm/ partnership firm/ Member practising in his individual name if any of the partner/ proprietor/Member practising in his individual name is exclusively associated with Applicant as on 1st July 2024. Information about this new category will be communicated to the banks for non-statutory branch audit assignments and also with other authorities who require MEF panel.

→ **Representation for Reconsideration of Pre-Qualification Criteria to bid in “Invitation for Proposal for Empanelment to take up Assignments Relating to Forensic Audits” issued by Home Department, Government of Maharashtra**

It was intimated to Professional Development Committee that the Home Department, Government of Maharashtra has issued “Invitation for Proposal for Empanelment to take up Assignments Relating to Forensic Audits” where the Pre-Qualification Criteria given for proposal required immediate attention.

In this regard, on recommendation of Digital Accounting and Assurance Board (DAAB) and with the approval of Chairman, PDC,

a representation was submitted to Home Department, Government of Maharashtra wherein it was emphasized that Chartered Accountants are also trained for Digital Forensics in the Certificate Course of FAFD and that ICAI had issued a special standard FAIS 420 related to gathering of evidence in digital domain. Additionally, it was brought to their attention that FAIS allows Chartered Accountant to take the help of experts in the relevant field. Hence, Chartered Accountants shall also be allowed to participate in the bid related to Digital Forensics.

→ **Certificate Course of Project Financing (Physical Batch)**

The Professional Development Committee successfully completed its 1st batch of Certificate Course on Project Financing which was held from 17th August to 1st September 2024 in Mumbai. 32 members registered for the course. The Assessment Test for the same was conducted for 5th January 2025. The result was declared on 16th January 2025 and was informed through an announcement hosted on the Institute's website www.icai.org

→ **PDC organised various Webinar series-DNA (Discover New Avenues)**

- “Venturing in the field of Project Financing” on 25th April 2024 that will help CAs leverage their core competencies to tap into this lucrative and evolving field.
- “NBFC Sector and Professional Opportunities for CAs” on 23rd May 2024 that will help CAs to successfully navigate these challenges and establish themselves as indispensable advisors in this rapidly evolving sector.
